Training Workshops

The Poppy Project is running training events for statutory and voluntary agencies to enhance awareness of adult human trafficking with a focus on supporting female victims.

Workshop Aims

Aim 1: To provide you with an overview of national and international policy and legislation as it applies to victims of trafficking, including the Council of Europe Convention on Action Against Trafficking in Human Beings.

Aim 2: To ensure that you are able to identify a victim of trafficking and understand the principles of sensitive victim identification, including an introduction and overview of the National Referral Mechanism.

Aim 3: To promote best practice in victim care, including principles of intervention. To provide guidelines on the provision of support services which prioritise the safety and well-being of victims.

Aim 4: To provide an overview of the rights, entitlements and options for victims of trafficking, including access to support, justice, compensation and protection.



Who should receive the training? Anyone in the statutory, voluntary or community sectors in contact with victims of trafficking, including women's organisations, housing and support services, asylum seeker support services, social services and community safety groups. The workshops would also be of interest to those focussing on trafficking as part of their studies.

Cost: £100 for statutory agencies or £75 for voluntary agencies.

Each workshop is at intermediate level and you do not need prior knowledge of trafficking to participate. The Poppy Project is also able to offer in-house training which can be tailored to the needs of your organisation. The workshops can be delivered over one or two days.
